We'd like to encourage children across Wirral to get out and about and enjoy the local green spaces. This year, as part of our Year of Environment, we are competing in Liverpool City Region's Greenspace Challenge. This year-long challenge invites Wirral to discover and share sightings of the animals, insects and plants that they can see in our local area.

We would like to invite you to join the challenge and help Wirral battle to reach the top of the wildlife spotting leader board. We want to encourage our younger generations to get more active and to enjoy getting outdoors. The challenge also shows them the importance of the wildlife around us and the importance of protecting it. By getting involved, you can help identify more animals and plants that might need conserving or managing in our local parks and spaces.

To take part you'll need to download the 'iNaturalist' app on a mobile or tablet from the App Store or Google Play. Simply spot any sort of wildlife at any of Wirral's parks, take a picture and share your observation by uploading to iNaturalist.

With our recent success in the City Nature Challenge, when we joined forces with our fellow Liverpool City Region competitors to compete in an international challenge with 159 other cities worldwide and placed 24<sup>th</sup> in the observation leader board, we are keen to continue our success.

The Year of Environment is an initiative that showcases the city region's natural assets and celebrates the valuable work done by many in the region to maintain the local environment. You too can help maintain and protect the wildlife that we have in our local area by taking part in the Greenspace Challenge.
